Update Regarding PA Bankers' Events

The health and safety of our members and staff remains our top priority during the COVID-19 pandemic. As part of our ongoing effort to follow the current Pennsylvania and federal guidelines, PA Bankers has made the following decisions regarding events, effective through May 31:

- **PA Bankers 2020 Convention has been cancelled.** All registrants, speakers and sponsors will receive a follow-up email with more details about this cancellation later today. In accordance with the association's bylaws, the annual meeting will be rescheduled to a virtual platform by June 30, and we will update our membership when a time and date are finalized.
- **All in-person banker seminars and conferences through May 31 have been postponed.** Our team is working to reschedule these events and will notify impacted registrants immediately of the postponement and share new dates for training as soon as they are confirmed.
- **All committee and other in-person meetings will be transitioned to conference calls, where possible, or rescheduled to a later date.**
