



## **UPDATE: Gov. Revises Life-Sustaining Businesses List, Joint Trade Association Letter to Governor and Press Release**

Today, the Pennsylvania Bankers Association (PA Bankers), joined by the Pennsylvania Association of Community Bankers (PACB) and CrossState Credit Union Association, [sent a letter](#) to Gov. Wolf to assure him of the financial services sector's commitment to Pennsylvania's consumers and businesses during this COVID-19 emergency.

The associations thanked the Governor for his efforts to make Pennsylvania's essential business guidelines fully compliant with the federal guidance set forth by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and emphasized the need to continually recognize banks and credit unions as essential service providers in his communications with the public during this crisis.
